- 7,400 linear feet of 8" PVC CI 200 Water Line,
- 3,000 linear feet of 6" PVC CI 200 Water Line,
- 150 linear feet of 16" DIP with aluminum jacketed insulation attached to bridge,
- 4 Each Sub-meters, and
- Miscellaneous accessories and appurtenances to complete the project
