Separate sealed Bids for the **2019 Sewer System Improvements – Oak Hill Drive Sewer Line** will be received by the City of Portland at the City Hall, located at 100 South Russell Street, Portland, TN 37148 until 11:00 A.M., C.D.T, Thursday, June 20, 2019 and then at said time and place publicly opened and read aloud.

The scope of work generally consists of the installation of approximately 245 linear feet of 8” diameter ductile iron gravity sewer line and 2 manholes with all appurtenances thereto, and abandoning in place an existing lift station.

Failure to pay the plan deposit and obtaining Contract Documents from locations other than Hethcoat & Davis, Inc. will result in Bidder not being considered and Bid will not be accepted. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all Bids.

Each Bidder must deposit with his Bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

All Bidders must be licensed General Contractors as required by the Contractor’s Licensing Act of 1994 of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee, and qualified for the type of construction being bid upon.

No Bidder may withdraw his Bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
